

Lame or limping

Trips and stumbles just being 'clumsy'





Slower on walks

Peculiar way of walking - leg swings out / bunny-hopping





Unable to jump onto bed or car or hesitates before jumping

Five of the many ways our dogs may show us they are experiencing discomfort or pain.




Muscular changes - larger/smaller or asymmetrical







Coat is no longer smooth or has texture patterns/changes









Sits or lies in an unusual position

Five of the many ways our dogs may show us they are experiencing discomfort or pain.




Seen as being lazy, grumpy, depressed, anti-social or stubborn

Reacts to touch on a particular part of their body






Reluctant to move or perform simple tasks
